

Ilysa Razom: assistance to victims of Russia-Ukraine War



Non-governmental, non-profit organization dedicated to charitable activities for the benefit of the Ukrainian society

THE GOAL OF ORGANIZATION

Providing food, medicines and clothing to vulnerable people affected by the war. The volunteers make every effort to ensure that the civilians get everything necessary for their everyday needs.

"Early Birds" – assistance to prematurely born babies

During the war, the number of premature births in Ukraine has sharply increased, while maternity wards capacitates decreased.

A private initiative is run by Elena Ipatova and her volunteer team. They work with maternity wards and young mothers near (in) the war zones to provide neonatal incubators, newborn carriers, baby food and specific medicines.

A reputable NGO initially formed to help Ukrainians affected by the Russian invasion in 2014. Now they provide help to people in the war zone in the east. They operate a phone hotline coordinating refugee support around the country and purchase and deliver basic necessities to the communities right in the fighting zone, including food, hygiene, medicines, diesel electro generators and fuel etc.

Support centres "I am Mariupol"

"I am Mariupol" is not just a center of support. It is also the hub for diasporas of Mariupol residents within Ukraine, it is the answer to urgent questions of the people and real support from local authorities.

The centers work by analogy with the Family Support Centers, which were implemented in 2015 and worked effectively in Mariupol.

What we are doing: 1. Identification of Mariupol residents in communities 2. Information support 3. Legal support 4. Assistance in recovering and obtaining documents 5. Providing humanitarian assistance 6. Needs analysis and monitoring 7. Help in finding the missing 8. Finding and assisting in the return of deportees.

Support centres "I am Mariupol"



At the first stage - to open 5 regional centers

Coverage: 112 thousand displaced persons (60% of displaced Mariupol residents)

The main headquarters is in Zaporizhzhia

Stages of implementation:

- 1. Dnipro April
- 2. Vinnytsya April
- 3. Kyiv May
- 4. L'viv May
- 5. Odesa May

Proposed budget: USD 15,000 to support Vinnytsya center
